

## **Access to Joseph Banks Reserve**

### **By car**

The main entrance to Joseph Banks Reserve is in Manooka Place, Kareela. There is no vehicle access from Bates Drive. From Bates Drive, turn into Alpita St, then Garnet Rd, then Manooka Place.

### **By public transport**

Two bus routes, route 967 and 968, run between Jannali station and Miranda station, via Bates Drive and Garnet Rd. There are bus stops in Garnet Rd and Marshall Rd.

Joseph Banks Reserve is about a 20 minute walk from either Kirrawee station or Gymea station on the Illawarra Line.

### **By foot**

As well as the main entrance on Manooka Place, there is a pedestrian gate on Bates Drive open 9 am to 5 pm, 7 days a week, allowing walkers to walk right through the Reserve.

A visit to the Reserve can be included in a longer walk through Sutherland Shire.

Joseph Banks Reserve is about a 20 minute walk from either Kirrawee station or Gymea station on the Illawarra Line, or a longer walk from Sutherland, Jannali or Como stations.

### **By bicycle**

Joseph Banks Reserve is within 2 blocks of the shared bicycle path along Waratah St from Sutherland to Gymea. Turn off Waratah St at Bath Rd. There are bicycle racks at the Reserve.
